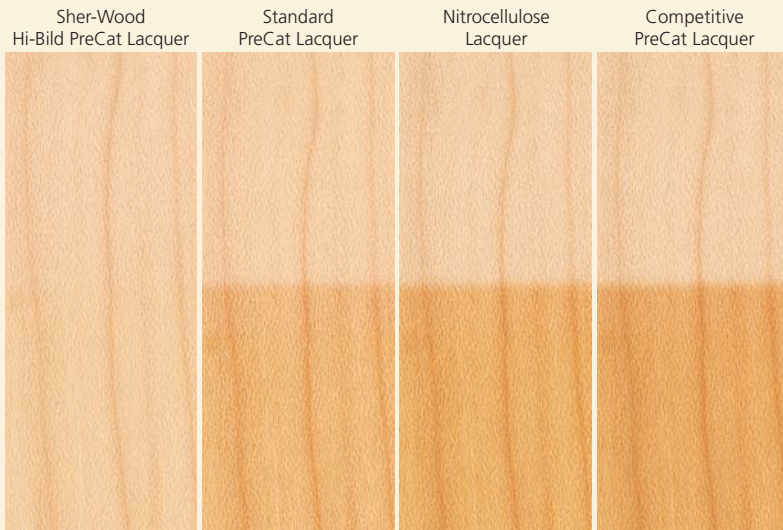

While all clear topcoats will change color to some extent when exposed to ultraviolet light, these pictures illustrate the variation expected between various clear finishing systems. Although critical to appearance, this variation in tendency to change color does not necessarily affect the other physical properties of the coating.

When darker woods or wood-toned stains are used, any color change that does occur is not as apparent. Other Sher-Wood topcoats which show greater tendency to change color are perfectly acceptable in these cases.
